RULES & REGULATIONS

LIQUID HONEY

Class 1-2 Liquid Honey ANY COLOUR

Honey exhibited in classes 1-6 must be shown in two identical standard trade jars. The jars must be round (not panelled) 375ml, unlabelled and in clear glass with a metal lid (gold, white or black). The two identical jars of honey must each contain 500g net weight of honey from the same batch. Liquid honey is judged on elements including clarity, moisture content, container appearance, cleanliness of the inside of the jars, flavour and aroma.

Natural granulated and creamed honey is judged on the evenness of grain, flavour, firmness and colour.

Class 3: Granulated Honey, fine grain

Two jars.

Class 4: Granulated Honey, coarse grain

Two jars.

Class 5: Floating Comb

Comb in liquid Honey (Chunk Honey). Piece of comb (approx. 110mm x 40mm) in liquid honey, both to be from the same floral source and comb. Two jars.

Class 6: Creamed Honey

Two Jars.

BEESWAX

Only pure beeswax is to be used, **no colouring** or decorative features.

Beeswax Candles receive points for appearance, burn response & wick, ease of lighting, feel, and cleanliness. The entry must be of the year of entry and not have been presented for judging before. Entries will be marked.

Class 7: Beeswax – light yellow

Not less than 500g in one block.

Class 8 Dark Beeswax

Not less than 500g in one block.

Class 9: Beeswax Sculpture

Artistic in design.

Class 10: Beeswax Candle

Artistic in design.

All awards are presented at the Honey Festival, Sunday 26 May 2024 at 3 pm. The entry collection starts after the award ceremony. Entries not collected by the end of the day will be donated to a community organisation. Each entry is judged and marked accordingly to the regulations above and participants are encouraged to enclose a stamped and self addressed envelope (1 envelope per participant) to receive their marking sheet/s. All entry numbers are placed on the honey jar/container **lid** or marked clearly visible on the wax/sculptor box/wrapping. It is your responsibility to check that;

1. your entry numbers are correctly placed
2. your name, address and all entry numbers are listed on the entry sheet & return envelope

We thank you for the support, passion and pride you demonstrate with your entry and wish you the best of luck for a successful outcome! We thank you for your respect to all the volunteers who make this a successful event!

AWARD LOGO

Medal winners in the 2024 competition will also receive via email a graphic representation of awarded medal. This medal is awarded to the winning production batch (used in retail), and we encourage you to use this symbol for marketing, promotional and information purposes. Graphic representation of the medal should be only used with information about the year of the competition.
